FRACTURED FAIRYTALE: AUDITION MONOLOGUES

STEP 1:

CHOOSE YOUR MONOLOGUE.

PLEASE SEE THE AUDITION MONOLOGUES BELOW. WHEN PICKING YOUR MONOLOGUE, THINK ABOUT WHAT CHARACTER FROM THE SHOW YOU WOULD ENJOY PLAYING.

STEP 2:

RECORD YOURSELF ACTING THE MONOLOGUE OUT.

THIS CAN BE DONE WITH ANY DEVICE WITH A CAMERA AND PLEASE MAKE SURE THE AUDIO IS CLEAR. YOU CAN GET YOUR PARENT TO HELP YOU FILM OR FILM IT YOURSELF, IT'S UP TO YOU!

PLEASE INTRODUCE YOURSELF AND WHICH ROLE YOU WOULD LIKE TO AUDITION FOR BEFORE ACTING OUT YOUR CHOSEN PIECE OF SCRIPT. PLEASE REMEMBER THIS ISN'T A MEMORY CONTEST, YOU'RE WELCOME TO READ THE MONOLOGUE OFF THE SHEET - WE ARE LOOKING FOR STRONG ACTING SKILLS!

FRACTURED FAIRYTALE: AUDITION MONOLOGUES

Monologue 1:

MALEFICENT (FEMALE)

Maleficent is our main villain throughout the story, she is dramatic and comical too, consider this for your monologue:

MALEFICENT: Now that I've cast a spell to create a portal transporting me to every realm. I thought about where I'd go, what riches I could make or Princesses I could KILL — I mean, uh, send to sleep —That's when I realised, I needed to do none of that, for now I have you — everyone will know my name and bow down to me! Would you like to hear my perfectly evil perfect plan? If all of the princes are coming through the portal, I can capture them all. And there will be nobody left to rescue the princesses! If they're stuck waiting to be rescued for ever I will be the fairest in all kingdoms by default! MWahahahah!

Monologue 2:

WOLF (MALE)

This monologue is spoken by WOLF. He is one of the featured characters in the show, he is not typically dressed; he wears suspenders and a fancy hat. He is slick and confident.

Wolf: Hello. I'm Wolf. I'm pretty famous around these woods, for my dashing good looks... and ridiculous appetite. Problem is... I'm trying out a new diet. Oh yes. I'm going vegan! But I'm so hungry I could eat a— (he looks at someone in the audience) no no no, don't do it Wolfy. People are very scared of me, though I can't think why? I don't look terrifying, do I? Oh look somebody's coming! Strange, I haven't seen a person like that before in these woods... normally they're dressed in red...

Monologue 3:

GODMOTHER (FEMALE)

Read this monologue in the style of a Fairy God Mother. Think bubbly and frivolous... and tired of making over princesses!

Godmother: Humph princesses these days! The expectations have lowered enormously! Now they're all 'gangstas' and 'getting tattoos'. I saw Cinderella getting one that said #ballyfe! I just hate the way they dress now! There's no class! Denim shorts? TANK TOPS?! Mrs Potts told me she saw Belle dying her hair purple the other day! And the princes love it. Not once has anyone ever asked me to the ball? Don't get me wrong I looove helping people, but I'd like to have fun and dance the night away until a specific time too? Ya know? [*Jasmine enters SR*] She sighs. Oh great, another one. (*Her tone changes*) Hello! My darling! Why look at you you're so close to getting to the ball!

FRACTURED FAIRYTALE: AUDITION MONOLOGUES

Monologue 4:

PRINCE CHARMING (MALE)

There are two Princes in this story! Both are very different, our first Prince is very confident and charming, whereas our second Prince isn't so sure. You can read for either of these monologues... or both!

Prince Charming 2: (To the audience) I'm trying so hard. I've never been in a real life situation with a real life princess before. It's not like our training at all. Maybe I should check the handbook... Ah yes, let's go back to basics. Chapter 1: Awesome introduction. I'm Prince Charming... the Prince of all... Charmings? I have come to valiantly rescue the..

A fanfare is heard.

Prince Charming 1: Prince Charming at your service! I have come to the rescue the damsel in distress and must engage in a quest to liberate her from an evil spell. I'm often described as "dashing" and "handsome" and "magnificent"! Nobody is as handsome or courageous as me! I have the strength of ten men and could fight any monster I wanted to in order to save the day!

Monologue 5:

MAGIC MIRROR (MALE OR FEMALE)

The magic mirror is a featured role, and talks to the audience throughout the show... they are played by female or male and we're looking for someone to put their own individual twist on this role.

Magic Mirror: From wicked queens, beautiful princesses, elves, monsters, and goblins, to giants, glass slippers, poisoned apples, magic keys — and mirrors — the characters and images of fairy tales have cast a spell over readers and audiences, both adults and children, for centuries. These fantastic stories have travelled across cultural borders, and been passed on from generation to generation, ever-changing, renewed with each re-telling. Few forms of literature have greater power to enchant us and rekindle our imagination than a fairy tale. Welcome to the land of the Magic Mirror, the tale of Snow White and the Seven Dwarves. There they are, can you see them? The story you're about to watch is not your average fairytale. In fact it is the complete opposite. Image a world where all of your favourite characters come to life right before your eyes. Where stories are strange and endings are re-written. Prepare to be amazed as I share all with you. This is a fractured fairytale...
